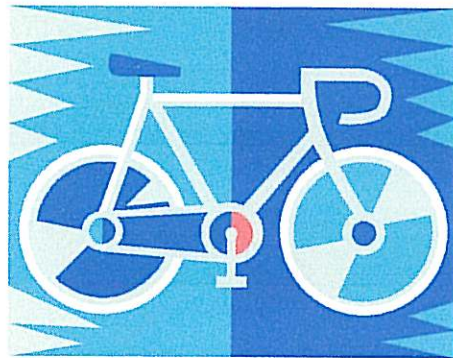

Here are some fun facts of knowledge that happened on the 2010~ 3 day "Trek Across Maine"

- 1,950 cyclists participated in the event
- 2,400 cyclists registered
- 685 volunteers registered
- \$1.6 million raised to date ~ with more to receive throughout the year ~A.L.A.M.E 's goal is to raise \$2 million
- Monies raised will be used for research, education and advocacy to promote lung health and prevent lung disease.

Over the weekend:

- Volunteers transported 4,461 pieces of luggage each day
- Trekkers consumed 1,440 pounds of grapes and 3,750 apples
- Trekkers rode a combined total of 348,300 miles
