III. Malloy (3) LPAs Public Hearing

Sam Malloy gave a brief overview of the three LPAs they have applied for with DMR.

- All oysters grow cages, flip bags, six-bag oysters condos design
- Each LPA would have 12 six-bag oystergro bottom cages
- He has attempted contact with other LPAs in the area but has not made contact with anyone to date. He has a call in to the Kelp farm LPA and is waiting for a call back.
- Environmentally, oysters and kelp are beneficial to the ecosystem.
- No eel grass issues sites are in deeper waters.

The public hearing for the Malloy LPAs began at 6:05 p.m., with no one from the public attending, and concluded at 6:20 p.m. The Harbormaster will sign off on the questionnaires on the LPAs and send back to DMR.
