To whom it may concern,

The Maine Department of Transportation is currently working on the final design for Protective Coatings of Concrete Surfaces for Region 1, I-295 Bridges, from South Portland to Topsham. The Win number for this project is 21762.00. Advertisement of the subject project for competitive bids is scheduled for April 2017. We estimate that the construction would begin approximately in June 2017 and be completed by October 2017.

The project is further described as follows:

Bridge Preservation - Protective Coatings. Region 1, I-295 bridges from South Portland to Topsham.

Traffic will be maintained using a single lane closure. All work on I-295 South of the Portland / Falmouth town line will be done at night from 10:00 pm until 6:00 am. All work on I-295 North of the Portland / Falmouth town line will be done at night from 9:00 pm until 6:00 am. Daytime single lane closures are allowed on the following roadways to access the contracted work without restricting I-295 traffic flow:

Kensington Street in Portland for access to Bridge # 5618
St. John Street in Portland for access to Bridge's # 6538 and # 6297
St. James Street in Portland for access to Bridge's # 6295 and # 6535
Sherwood Street in Portland for access to Bridge # 5617
Route 88 in Yarmouth to access Bridge's # 1507 and # 5832
Old Lewiston Rd in Topsham for access to Bridge's # 1511 and # 6269

We hereby request that you provide a copy of this notice to all municipal officials, employees and boards with responsibilities for utility and/or land-use planning/permitting, and that you post this letter on any municipal public bulletin boards, media outlets and/or municipal websites as a public meeting will not be held regarding this project unless specifically requested by the municipality.
