

Winter Driving in Maine



Drivers have the most trouble adjusting to wintry roads during the first storms of the season. Be ready to **significantly** slow down when roads are snowy, icy or slushy.

- Over 7,000 crashes occur on snow or ice-covered roadways each year in Maine.
- Snow or ice-covered roads greatly reduce your ability to brake and maneuver.
- 4-wheel drive does not reduce stopping distances, so slow down and leave plenty of following distance from the vehicle ahead.

And remember--always wear your seat belt!
