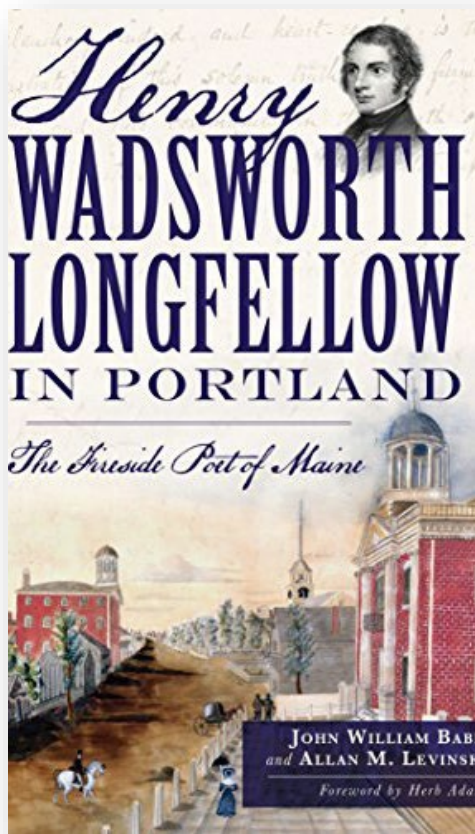


THE CUMBERLAND HISTORICAL SOCIETY PRESENTS...
