The 0457-7000 books/magazines/audiovisual account is subdivided using a formula that takes into account the previous year's circulation total; the circulation of the particular type of material (i.e., Adult Fiction, Juvenile, etc.) and the percentage of total circulation represented by that material type; and the average price of a particular type of material and the average discount on a material type the library can expect to receive. The formula results in a percentage of total funds available for each material type, which is then applied after fixed costs (such as expenditures on reference materials, magazines and downloadable materials) are subtracted from the total.
