TODAY'S CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

Blasters (McGoldrick) didn't arrive on-site until mid-day so Storey Brothers and Summit Natural Gas found others work to do. Storey Brothers grubbed the shoulder south of the current work zone and Summit started installing services at the Tuttle Road end of the project at 148 Middle Road.

McGoldrick started blasting ledge for the gas line trench in the areas skipped thus far.

Storey Brothers worked the rest of the day installing additional lengths of drainage pipe in the drainage easement at 55 Middle Road.

Dave Bernard completed flushing of water main extension. Passed pressure test. Began to chlorinate the system by chlorinating from northern end while bleeding water off the southern end.

Continue blasting for water main extension.

Continue installing natural gas main.

Resume road work.
