About 4 inches of pavement had been milled off leaving about 3 inches. This area is in a "full" box cut area.



Photograph 4 - Friday, September 15<sup>th</sup> – Test Pit 9 at STA 47+50 10' Left – Did not reach ledge at a depth of 45 inches below the milled pavement. Gravel/clay interface was about 18 inches below top of the 2 inches of milled pavement remaining. This area was in a "partial" box cut area.
