TODAY'S CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

McGoldrick resumed drilling & blasting for "long side" services ahead of waterline installation.

Storey Brothers returned to the installation of the water main extension where they left off August 30th at STA 26+21 (across from 54 Middle Rd. Driveway). Installed 352 LF southerly to STA 22+69 (45 Middle Road driveway). From a pipe stationing stand point the installation was from STA 23+05 to STA 26+57.

Water samples drawn for 4th time on the previously installed water main extension. Results expected noon, Tuesday.

TOMORROW'S ANTICIPATED CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

Continue installation of water main extension southward from STA 22+69.

Resume blasting for water main extension and services from stream crossing to Evergreen Lane.
