CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

Set-up pump for run-off from 158 Middle Road into CB-7E.
Located pre-existing 12-inch underdrain and painted route for natural gas line.
CMP arrived on-site. Moved out of work zone and install replacement pole (#332) at STA 70+18 south of driveway for 140 Middle Road (Lewis) then left.
Excavated for initial section of gas line between new underdrain and pre-existing underdrain.
Installed approximately 280 linear feet of gas line (and detection wire) in trench on sand bed, backfilled with sand to top of pipe, and backfilled with native material placing detection tape approximately 24-inches over pipe.
