- 1 Dozer CAT D5k2 (used for placement and initial grading of gravel)
- 1 Mini Excavator Case CX326B (used by Summit for cross trenching of services)
- 1 Backhoe Case 580N (equipped with hoe ram for ledge removal in gas service cross trench.

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

Instead of starting at the northern terminus of the project at Tuttle Road, work started at a particularly soft section of exposed gravel between Pole #335 and Pole#338.

Started excavation existing gravel on west side of road (southbound lane) near Pole#335 (STA 74+25) working in a northly direction.

Placed geotextile reinforcing fabric on undisturbed subgrade prior to placing new gravel with dozer.

At STA 78+75 near Pole#338 the operation switched to the east side of the road and proceeded in a southerly direction working back to the morning start point near STA 74+25 completing about 450 feet of road.

Before opening the road to 2-way traffic the gravel was compacted with a roller and treated with calcium chloride via a landscaping spreader to mitigate dust
