Work in Progress – Town of Cumberland

- > Crew #1 installing 4" gas main at the intersection of Skillin, Blackstrap, and Route 100.
- > Crew #2 installing long side $\frac{1}{2}$ " gas service at 2 Balsam Drive.

Discussions & Observations

Crew #1:

<u>Route 100</u>

- Work Zone Closure: One lane closed on Blackstrap Road and Skillin Road with flaggers maintaining the intersection as a four way stop.
- DG reminded Summit to be cautious of traffic delays on Route 100 during morning commute. During site visit at approximately 7:45 AM traffic appeared to be flowing adequately.
- Crew installed approximately 450' from near Copp Motors on Skillin Road to near the "Fire Danger" sign at the Fire Station on Blackstrap Road.
- All utilities located via manhole inverts, camera, electronic locator, or hand excavated.
- > Depth of utilities are to top of pipe unless noted in table below.

- Crew backfilled trenches and potholes with sand around the gas main and gravel. Backfill was compacted in lifts with a jumping jack.
- > Trenches and potholes were left gravel due to their size and location.
- > Crew clean worksite and traffic returned to normal at approximately 3:00 PM.

<u>Crew 2:</u>

2 Balsam Drive

- Work Zone Closure: I lane closed on Balsam Drive with flaggers maintaining alternating one way traffic.
- Crew installing 1/2" gas service by open trench and automatic punch method. Crew installed ½" gas service from 2 Balsam Drive to the edge of roadway. Crew did not cross roadway.
- > 1/2" service was installed at approximately 3' depth.
- Brandon indicated he received permission to pothole the roadway to locate the water main and sewer. Crew did not pot hole in roadway.
- All utilities located via manhole inverts, camera, electronic locator, or hand excavated.
- > Depth of utilities are to top of pipe unless noted in table below.

- Balsam Drive Roadway and curb was damaged by the excavator tracks. GP to review with town to determine if a corrective action should be taken.
- Crew backfilled trench with sand around the gas main and service, with excavated material above the sand. Backfill was compacted in lifts with jumping jack.
- Crew cleaned work area and traffic returned to normal by 5:00 PM
