Per our earlier discussion we have prepared a revised plan set which reflects a number of deminimis changes to the original plans. The changes include the following:

- The multiplex footprint was revised to enable better entering and exiting of the end unit garage.

- Finished grades were lowered slightly to reduce fill and assist with balancing earthwork.
- Water service is shown based on comments from the Portland Water District and the sprinkler design company.
