Chapter 250. Subdivision of Land Article X. Street Design and Construction Standards

§ 250-37. General street standards.

- A. Classification. In accordance with the Comprehensive Plan of the Town of Cumberland and for the purposes of these standards, streets are classified according to the average daily traffic (ADT) they are intended to serve, as calculated by the number of average daily trips, as follows:
 - (7) Commercial access streets. Access streets shall be defined as streets servicing commercial and industrial subdivisions with average daily trips less than 2,000.
 - (8) Residential collector street. Collector streets serve as collectors from subcollector streets and as feeders to arterial streets; they are intended to serve subdivisions with average daily trips equal to or greater than 500.
