

Bea Lane

(Note: Located in Kerrydale Vista subdivision, section C, recorded in the Registry of Deeds, Plan Book 66, page 18.)

September 23, 1965

Bea Lane accepted at special town meeting with provision that the developer is not relieved of his obligation to meet town specifications.

March 5, 1966

Town Meeting Voted to accept Bea Lane, described as follows:

A certain strip of land situated in the Town of Cumberland, County of Cumberland, and State of Maine, on the northwesterly side of Main Street, said strip of land being forty (40) feet in width and shown as a road on a plan entitled Section C, a portion of Kerrydale Vista, made for Carlan Burnell and recorded in Cumberland County Registry of Deeds, Plan Book 66, Page 18, being that portion of said forty (40) foot strip extending from said Main Street northwesterly between property owned by Carlan Burnell and lot No. 12, nine-hundred (900) feet, more or less to the intersection of Gross Street on said plan, being more particularly bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a granite monument on the northwesterly side of Main Street and the southerly corner of land owned by Carlan Burnell as shown on the plan: thence northwesterly along land owned by Carlan Burnell with the included angle of the Burnell land and the Main Street being 91 degrees and 25 minutes, nine-hundred and seven tenths (900.7) feet to a granite monument at the intersection of Gross Street and the northwest corner of lot No. 19. Said description being the northeasterly boundary of a forty (40) foot strip of land as shown on the plan.
