LENGTH: 901' (.17 MILES) WIDTH: 24'

March 4, 1967

Town Meeting voted to accept the Town Way as laid out by the Selectmen and described as follows:

A certain lot or parcel of land situated in the Town of Cumberland, County of Cumberland and State of Maine, being a portion of Brookside Drive in said Cumberland, bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the westerly sideline of Greely Road three hundred twenty-five (325) feet northerly from a stone monument at the land of Nelson Blanchard; thence westerly and making an included angle of 93 degrees 55', through the southwest, with the southerly direction of Greely Road a distance of eight hundred ten (810) feet to a traffic turnaround; thence westerly on a continuation of same course, a distance of forty-five (45) feet to the center of said traffic turnaround having a radius of forty-five (45) feet; said street to be fifty (50) feet wide and to lie equally on each side of the above described line, and to be known as Brookside Drive.
