LENGTH: 938' (.18 MILES) WIDTH: 20'

Town meeting voted to accept as Town Way, provided the developer meets Town specifications,

Cottage Farms Road: A certain strip of land situated in the Town of Cumberland, County of Cumberland, and State of Maine, on the northwesterly side of Main Street, said strip of land being fifty (50) feet in width formally designated as smith Street and shown as a road on a plan entitled Greenwood at Cumberland made for Yankee Acreage and recorded in Cumberland County Registry of Deeds, Plan Book 67, Page 21, being that portion of said fifty (50) foot strip extending from said Main Street northwesterly between property owned by Everett Weir and Frye six hundred and fifty (650) feet, more or less to lot 17 on said Plan, being more particularly bounded and described as follows: Beginning at a granite monument on the northwesterly side of Main Street at the southeasterly corner of land owned by FRye as shown on the plan; thence northwesterly along said land owned by Frye one hundred and seventy-three (173) feet to a granite monument; thence along a westerly course along a lot 2 of the plan whose included angle is 135 degrees and no minutes on hundred seventy-four and seventy-eight hundredths (174.78) feet to a granite monument; thence northwesterly along a course whose included angle is 135 degrees and 15 minutes three hundred and two and fifty-three hundredths (302.53) feet to the southeasterly corner of Lot 17. Said description being southwesterly boundary of a fifty (50) foot strip of land as shown on the plan.
