LENGTH: 3,295' (.62 MILES)

WIDTH: 22'

Council meeting of October 26, 1981

Voted to accept Friar Lane:

Councilor Allen moved to accept Friar Lane as proposed on the condition that the developer will furnish a letter to the Town Manager that he will establish grass or other protective cover;

Deleted as per November 9, 1981 Meeting:

(to areas described within the right of way due to residential driveway construction),

and to repair any shoulder area where grass does not become established this fall.

Seconded by Councilor Webster Yes - 4 No - 2 (Damon, Murray)

**NOTE: the 2nd half of Friar Lane protective cover for shoulder repair established and completed and accepted August 28th, 1989.
