own Meeting voted to accept as a Town Way, provided the developer meets Town specifications:

KATHY LANE: Beginning at a point in the easterly side of the Gray Road and southerly side of the Skillings Road and then in an easterly direction a distance of four hundred fifty (450) feet along the southerly sideline of Skillings Road to a stone monument then at right angles to Skillings Road 171 degrees 45' a distance of 139.4 feet to a monument and then 178 degrees 40' a distance of 832.5 feet to a stone monument thence in an easterly direction 89 degrees 51' a distance of fifty (50) feet to a stone monument, thence in a northerly direction 181 degrees 60' a distance of 833.2 feet to a monument thence northerly 188 degrees 55' a distance of one-hundred forty (140) feet to a stone monument thence fifty (50) feet along the southerly sideline of the Skillings Road in an easterly direction to first mentioned stone monument.

Meaning and intending to convey a parcel of land fifty (50) feet wide and approximately nine-hundred seventy-five (975) feet long for a street to be called Kathy Lane.

Said street being shown on plan of Allen's Park and recorded at the Cumberland County Registry of Deeds, Plan Book 68, Page 2.
