96-119 To consider and act on recommendation of Board of Trustees of Portland Water District regarding trustee compensation.

Councilor Drummond moved the following:
WHEREAS, Section 18 of the Charter of the Portland
Water District currently provides that each Trustee
of the District shall receive as compensation for
services the sum of \$1,200 per year;
WHEREAS, the compensation of the Trustees has not
been increased since 1975;
WHEREAS, the Trustees devote substantial time to the
business of the District; and,
WHEREAS, the Trustees recommend that th compensation
for Trustees be increased to reflect reasonable

WHEREAS, the Trustees recommend that th compensation for Trustees be increased to reflect reasonable compensation for their services, effective January 1, 1997,

VOTED: That in accordance with Section 6303(4) of Title 35-A of the Maine Revised Statutes Annotated, to approve the amendment of Article XI of the Bylaws of the District, previously adopted by the Board of Trustees, as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> Each Trustee of the District, other than the President, shall receive as compensation the sum of \$100 for each Regular Meeting, Special Meeting, or Workshop actually attended, with the total compensation not to exceed \$2,400 per year.

The President of the District shall receive as compensation the sum of \$125 for each Regular Meeting, Special Meeting, or workshop actually attended, with the total compensation not to exceed \$3,000 per year.

<u>Section 2.</u> The District may reimburse a Trustee for travel and expenses incurred in connection with District business, other than attendance at Trustee meetings, in accordance with District policy.

Councilor Bingham seconded. Vote: 6 in favor 1 opposed (Phipps)
