Town Meeting Voted to accept as a town way:

Certain lot or parcel of land situated in said Cumberland, being

known as Longview Street, bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the southwesterly sideline of Hillcrest Drive, said point being distant one hundred nine and six tenths (109.6) feet southeasterly from the southeasterly terminus of Hillcrest Drive as laid out and accepted by the Town of Cumberland on March 3, 1962;

Thence along a curve to the southwest having a radius of twenty-five (25) feet, a distance of thirty-nine and twenty-seven hundredths (39.27) feet to a point of tangent;

Thence southwesterly and tangent to the last described course, a distance of three hundred nineteen and ninety-nine hundredths (319.99)

feet to a point of curvature;

Thence along a curve to the northwest having a radius of twenty-five (25) feet, a distance of thirty-nine and twenty-seven hundredths (39.27) feet to the northeasterly sideline of Woodside Drive;

Thence southeasterly along a curve to the northeast, having a radius of twenty-five (25) feet, a distance of thirty-nine and twenty-seven hundredths (39.27) feet to a point of tangent;

Thence northeasterly and tangent to the last described course, a distance of three hundred nineteen and ninety-nine hundredths (319.99)

feet to a point of curvature;

Thence southeasterly along a curve to the southeast having a radius of twenty-five (25) feet, a distance of thirty-nine and twenty-seven hundredths (39.27) feet to the southwesterly side line of Hillcrest Drive;

Thence northwesterly along the southwesterly side line of HillCrest Drive, a distance of ninety(90) feet to the point of beginning. Said street to be forty (40) feet wide and to lie entirely within the limits of the above described lines, and to be known as Longview Street as delineated on a Plan of Silas Baker Property owned by Stanley N. Brown, Section B, dated October 24, 1961 and recorded in said Registry of Deeds in Plan Book 60, Page 21.
