Know all men by these presents, that we, Sidney R. Bennett and Hilda C. Bennett, both of Cumberland and County of Cumberland, State of Maine in considerations paid by the Inhabitants of the Town of Cumberland, a body political and corporate, organized under the laws of the State of Maine and located in the County of Cumberland and State of Maine the receipt whereof we do acknowledge, do hereby give, grant, and sell and convey unto the said Inhabitants of the Town of Cumberland, its successors and assigns, forever, a certain lot or parcel of land situated in said Cumberland and bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pipe on the southeasterly sideline of Main Street, said pipe being distant one hundred eighty-eight (188) northeasterly along said sideline of Main Street from a point marking the most westerly corner of land of the grantors and the most northerly corner of land of the grantee and occupied by Greely Institute; thence north 50 degrees 30' east along said line of Main Street a distance of forty $(4\bar{0})$ feet to an iron pipe at the most westerly corner of land formerly of Osgood and now of Liberty; thence south 38 degrees 53' west along the the southwesterly line of said Liberty land three hundred (300) feet to an iron pipe in the northwesterly side of land recently conveyed by the grantors to the grantees; thence south 51 degrees 30' west along said sideline of land of the grantee forty (40) feet to an iron pipe; thence north 38 degrees 53' west three hundred (300) feet to the point of beginning. Meaning and intending to convey and hereby conveying a strip of land forty (40) feet in width and three hundred (300) feet in length extending from Main Street to land recently conveyed by the grantors to the grantee, the northeasterly side line of said strip being the northeasterly side line of land of the grantors and the southwesterly side line thereof being parallel to and forty (40) feet distant from the northwesterly side line.

Being a portion of the premises conveyed to the grantors by deeds of Mollie M. Herrick and Mollie M. Herrick, Administratix, recorded in the Cumberland County Registry of Deeds in Book 1860, Page 204 and in Book 1749, Page 315.
