- Shaw Brothers crew fine graded the left lane on the in the middle and southern portions of the project.

Discussions/Observation

- 7:30 am – AJA arrived on site. Crew had set up traffic control closing the southbound lane in the area of the Maine Standards Company and Tuttle Road. Crew was grading base gravel opposite Tuttle Rd.
- 8:15 am – AJA left the site.
- 4:00 pm – AJA arrived on site. Crew was fine grading on the northern end of the southern portion of the project.
- 4:15 pm - AJA and JF discussed the plan for paving and any outstanding questions. JF stated that Shaw Brothers would require the pavement placed behind the face of the guardrail be paid as Pavement Incidentals (403.209). AJA stated this would be acceptable. Both parties would agree to a quantity placed by hand after installation.
- 4:45 pm – AJA left the site.
