## Work in Progress

Crew removed pavement and grubbed off loam in the left lane from STA 38+00 through STA 13+00. Crew used existing gravel to construct a ramp at the edge of pavement to eliminate a vertical drop from pavement to gravel.

## **Discussions/Observation**

- 5:30 am AJA and JF discussed that the crew would be working on Route 1 for the morning, the day was tentitivly planned to end at 12:00 PM.
- 7:00 am AJA arrived on site. Crew had set up traffic control and had begun pavement removal in the left lane in the area south of Chelsea Lane. The south bound lane was closed to traffic at the work area. 3 flaggers maintained alternating one way traffic.
- 7:30 am AJA and JF discussed the construction of a gravel ramp at the edge of pavement. AJA requested it be compacted with a roller prior to closing the site for the day. JF agreed to compact the gravel ramp.
- $\blacktriangleright$  7:45 am AJA left the site.
- I 2:50 pm JF contacted AJA and informed him that the crew was finishing work for the day. AJA and JF discussed the possibility of changing the width of the fog line from the originally specified 4" to 6". JF stated he would supply AJA with a proposed cost for the change.
- I:15 pm AJA arrived on site, crew had left for the day. The gravel ramp constructed where excavations had taken place was as discussed.
- I:30 pm AJA left the site.
