Shaw Brother's crew installed reclaimed material as road shoulders in the left lane in the southern portion of the project.

Discussions/Observation

- > 7:30 am AJA arrived on site. Crew had set up traffic control closing the southbound lane of Route 1, controlling alternating one way traffic with flaggers.
- ➤ 8:00 am AJA and JF discussed the project schedule. Guardrail installation on the Tuttle Road Ramp to occur on 5/12/17. Milling under the Tuttle Road Overpass and butt joints to occur on 5/15/17. Second lift of base pavement in the right lane of Route I and surface pavement on the Tuttle Road Ramp to occur on 5/16/17. Surface pavement on Route I to be installed by tandem pavers on 5/17/17.
- > 8:30 am AIA left the site.
- ➤ 1:30 pm AJA arrive on site. Crew was continuing to install reclaimed material in the shoulders of the left lane on the southern portion of the project.
- > 1:45 pm AIA left the site.

Schedule of Work

- ➤ Reclaim installation in the shoulders to continue 5/12/17.
- ➤ Guardrail installation on the Tuttle Road Ramp to occur on 5/12/17.
- Milling under the Tuttle Road overpass to occur on 5/15/17.
- ➤ Paving on the northbound lane of Route I and Tuttle Road Ramp to occur on 5/16/17.
- ➤ Surface pavement on Route 1 to occur on 5/17/17.
