Wed. 4/05/16	Shaw Brothers crew box cut the left lane from STA 38+00 through STA 28+25. Crew also graded subgrade and installed base gravel in the box cut. Crew also saw cut 1,610 LF in the right lane from STA 110+50 through STA 120+00 and from STA 131+40 through STA 138+00.
Thurs 4/06/17	Shaw Brothers crew box cut 575 LF the left lane from STA 28+25 through STA 22+50. Crew also graded subgrade and installed base gravel in the box cut. Crew also saw cut 680 LF in the right lane from STA 138+00 through STA 144+80.
Fri 4/07/17	Shaw Brothers crew box cut 900 LF the left lane from STA 22+50 through STA 13+50. Crew also graded subgrade and installed base gravel in the box cut.
Sat 4/08/17	No activity.
Sun 4/09/17	No activity.
Mon 4/10/17	Shaw Brothers crew box cut 700 LF the left lane from STA 13+50 through STA 6+50. Crew also graded subgrade and installed base gravel in the box cut.
Tues 4/11/17	Shaw Brothers crew box cut 325 LF the left lane from STA 6+50 through STA 3+25. Crew also graded subgrade and installed base gravel in the box cut. Crew also prepared structure for raising of frames and covers.

Mon 4/17/17	Shaw Brothers crew to begin base paving in the southbound lane.
Tues 4/18/17	Shaw Brothers crew to complete base paving in the southbound lane.

Useful Information and Highlights

- Shaw Brothers crew has reduced traffic to alternating one way in the construction zone. No notable traffic delays have been observed.
- Areas that have been fine graded will have a 4" drop from the pavement to the gravel. This drop will be clearly marked with signage, cones, and barrels. USE CAUTION when traveling south on Route I in the construction area.
- Electronic message boards have been installed on the north and south ends of the work to warn drivers that bicycles will be traveling in the main line of the roadway.
