Work Completed Last Week

Wed. 5/03/16	Shaw Brother's crew fine graded in the right lane on the northern end of the project.
Thurs 5/04/17	Shaw Brother's crew fine graded in the right lane on the northern end of the project and installed 61.5 LF of granite curb at a driveway entrance in the left lane north of Casco Bay Drive.
Fri 5/05/17	Shaw Brother's crew removed the existing guardrail on the Tuttle Road Ramp and began grading the shoulder/guardrail area.
Sat 5/06/17	No activity.
Sun 5/07/17	No activity.
Mon 5/08/17	The Shaw Brother's Grading/Reclaim Crew pulverized and graded 2025 square yards on the Tuttle Road Ramp. The Shaw Brother's Paving crew installed 396.12 tons of 12.5mm base pavement in two locations of the right lane of Route I and 245.26 tons of 12.5mm base pavement on both lanes of the Tuttle Road Ramp.
Tues 5/09/17	Shaw Brother's crew graded the side slopes of the Tuttle Road Ramp. Crew also installed temporary ramps at the drives and side roads that crossed the base pavement installed the previous day.

Work Schedule Next Week

Wed. 5/10/16	Shaw Brother's crew to begin installed reclaim material in the shoulder of Route I.
Thurs 5/11/17	Shaw Brother's crew to continue installing reclaim material in the shoulder of Route I. Guardrail installation on the Tuttle Road Ramp to begin.
Fri 5/12/17	Shaw Brother's crew to complete installing reclaim material in the shoulder of Route I.
Sat 5/13/17	No activity.
Sun 5/14/17	No activity.
Mon 5/15/17	Shaw brothers crew to mill pavement under the Tuttle Road overpass and begin milling butt joints.
Tues 5/16/17	Shaw brothers to complete milling of butt joints.
