Shaw Brother's crew fine graded in the right lane on the northern end of the project.

- ➤ Shaw Brother's Crew installed 61.5 LF of granite curb at a driveway entrance in the left lane north of Casco Bay Drive.
- Shaw Brother's Crew used 3 tons of hand placed HMA around the granite curb.

Discussions/Observation

- > 7:30 am AJA arrived on site. Crew was fine grading in the the right lane in the area north of Tuttle road.
- > 8:00 am JF began preparing to set granite curb north of Casco Bay Dr. on the west side of the street. Crew used 3 tons of hand placed HMA to base around the granite curb.
- > 8:30 am AIA left the site.
- > 9:00 am JF contacted AJA to inform him that the existing road grade was 1%. AJA directed JF to grade the box cut area at 2%. The road slope will be adjusted to to a constant 2% with the 3/4" overlay. The paving crew will need to be instructed to pave the right lane first, running depth on the ditch side of the road and use automation to maintain the 2% slope.

Schedule of Work

- Fine grading in the right lane to continue on 5/5/17.
- Reclaiming of Tuttle Road to occur on 5/8/17.
- ➤ Base paving to begin on 5/9/17.
