Work in Progress

- Crew performed 2200 linear feet of saw cutting in the left lane beginning at STA 22+50 heading north toward Yarmouth ending at STA 44+50.

Discussions/Observation

- 7:00 am - AJA on site. Crew mobilized to the roadway to begin saw cutting in the left lane. Traffic shifted east, with two way traffic maintained. Flaggers were placed on the north and south ends of the work for occasional traffic stoppages.
- 7:30 am – Crew was observed offsetting Summit Natural Gas DIGSAFE markings 15' east.
- 8:00 am – AJA off site.
- 8:15 am – JF contacted AJA to inquire about limits of excavation in the guardrail section. AJA informed JF that the guardrail would remain and excavation would occur inside of the guardrail.
- 4:30 pm – AJA on site. Crew continuing the sawcutting in the left lane.
- 4:45 pm – Saw cutting in the left lane on the Falmouth end of the project was completed.
- 5:15 pm – Traffic control devices removed from the roadway. Crew off site.

- Pavement removal to begin on Monday 3/27/17.
