

To hold a Public Hearing to consider and act on a Minor Mass Gathering Permit application for Portland Ovations "Circus Smirkus" to be held August 5th and 6th at the Cumberland Fairgrounds



Please forward to the Town Council for consideration a Minor Mass Gathering application for Circus Smirkus to be held at Cumberland Fair Grounds on August 5 & 6, 2024. Shows will be held 1-3PM and 6-8PM each day.

This event will be brought to us by Portland Ovations. This event is new to Cumberland and has been performing for 36 years across VT, MA, NH, CT, and ME.

Application, payment, and certificate of Insurance have been provided.

The Fire Chief and the Police Chief have no concerns and have submitted invoices for each event.

- The approximate costs for fire and police for this event = \$3,242.24
 - Police: \$ 1,194.24
 - Fire/Rescue: \$ 2,048.00

Circus Smirkus sells popcorn and soft drinks for their events, no other vendors will be present.

Expected attendance per performance is 600, space available for 700.

They will have 5 portable toilets (1 designated ADA) available, and 6 circus owned refuse containers, and 2 - 10yd dumpsters (rented from Casella). Refuse will be emptied onsite by staff and dumpsters will be picked up on Wednesday August 8th in the morning.

I anticipate that this event will be successful and well managed.

Circus Smirkus is a traveling youth circus made up of an auditioned company of Smirkus Troupers, ages 10 to 18, and perform in the summer months. They are supported by adults: professional coaches, cooks, musicians and crew. Smirkus has been performing for 36 years (2024 will be our 37th year). We are an animal-free show. In 2023, Circus Smirkus performed in 62 shows in 14 cities spread across VT, MA, NH, CT, and ME, beginning July 1 and ending. August 18. Our Smirkos perform to sell-out crowds in Circus Smirkus' very own 700-seat European-style one-ring big top tent. Each year brings a new storyline and original full-length show combining the best in traditional and contemporary circus styles. We give our Troupers the full experience of touring in a classic traveling tent show. That means a complete immersion in circus life. Smirkos endure rigorous training, daily chores and the loading in and loading out of the Big Top. They revel in the joy of performance and the camaraderie of a common purpose. Our three most recent outdoor performances were held at our final tour location at our Smirkus headquarters located in Greensboro VT, August 18-19, 2023, performing to sold out shows (700-710/show). The Circus Barn, Inc (dba Circus Smirkus) is a non profit organization. We have a variety of sponsors (banks, magazine, radio stations), and a large group of generous donor supporters. We have been performing in Kennebunkport ME for many years, and performed in Portland ME in 2023 as well.

During each of this event's scheduled times the fire department will have two EMS personnel on the grounds assigned specifically for this event. Per the contract of Local 340 the minimum coverage time is 4 hours. The crew, with ambulance, will be on-site at a minimum of 30 minutes prior to and 30 minutes after the scheduled times. The charges for the event coverage are as follows:

Should the event continue beyond the times included in the Mass Gathering Application our staffing costs will be increased on an hourly basis for two EMS providers. The hourly cost per person is \$64.00.

Fees may be charged directly to individuals who are medically evaluated/treated by the Cumberland EMS personnel.
