Re: Town Garage Meetings

We are now approaching the end of our 4th year in pursuit of a location for the Town Garage. We now have a location and a partner in the Cumberland County Riding Club and a location at Skillins Road.

I met with the Riding Club this past Friday evening and with Bond Counsel and the Town Attorney this past Thursday. All involved parties will be ready to move forward with the Skillins Road Plan once the Town Council has approved Phase I. I will be recommending we consider adding the Fire Ladder Truck to the initial Bond Package (\$1.3M) and the first Phase of the garage at \$3.4 M for a \$4.7 M Bond. Our Bond Counsel believes this is the best strategy moving forward. The Town Attorney and Bond Counsel believe presenting the entire project as we have discuss is a good strategy so multiple referendums would not happen each time the next phase was ready to move forward.

Bond 1- 2019 Fire Truck \$1.3M and Town Garage Phase 1 (\$3.4 M) \$4.7M Bond 2- 2023 Town Garage Mechanical Services Structure \$5.2M

The Town Council will be asked to authorize up to \$9.9 M in new debt for a new Fire Truck and Town Garage. Council <u>authorization for Phase 2 will be required pursuant</u> to the October 8, 2018 Council Order.

I recommend I present the overall plan at your September 24th meeting along with Dan Diffin from Sevee & Maher Engineers.
